Seasonal Activities

Benefice Walk Saturday 27th July

Everyone is welcome on our benefice walk on Saturday 27th July.

There are 2 walks centred on Amport and we can have lunch afterwards at the Hawk Inn.

Route A is a 4 miles circular walk from The Hawk Inn which takes us north past gardens and through fields to East Cholderton then back to The Hawk. The going is easy on well-defined public footpaths and a few short stretches on quiet roads. The gradients are gentle, but some surfaces are uneven and there are nettles and weeds overgrowing some sections so dress appropriately. Dogs must be kept on the lead in places and there are a few stiles. There are several access points if anyone needs to leave early. It takes about 2 hours. Park at The Hawk Inn and the walk starts at 10am.

Route B is a 2 miles circular route from The Hawk Inn to the north of Amport. The going is easy on well-defined public footpaths and a few short stretches on quiet roads. The gradients are gentle, but some surfaces are uneven and there are nettles and weeds overgrowing some sections so dress appropriately. It takes about 1 hour. Park at The Hawk Inn and the walk starts at 11am.

Route C is to skip the walks and go directly to The Hawk Inn where we should meet up around noon.

If you would like to come then please let me know as soon as possible. It would be helpful to know which route you prefer but you can change your mind at any time. However, if you would like to have a meal at The Hawk then you must let me know your menu choice by 20th July so that the chef can be ready for us. 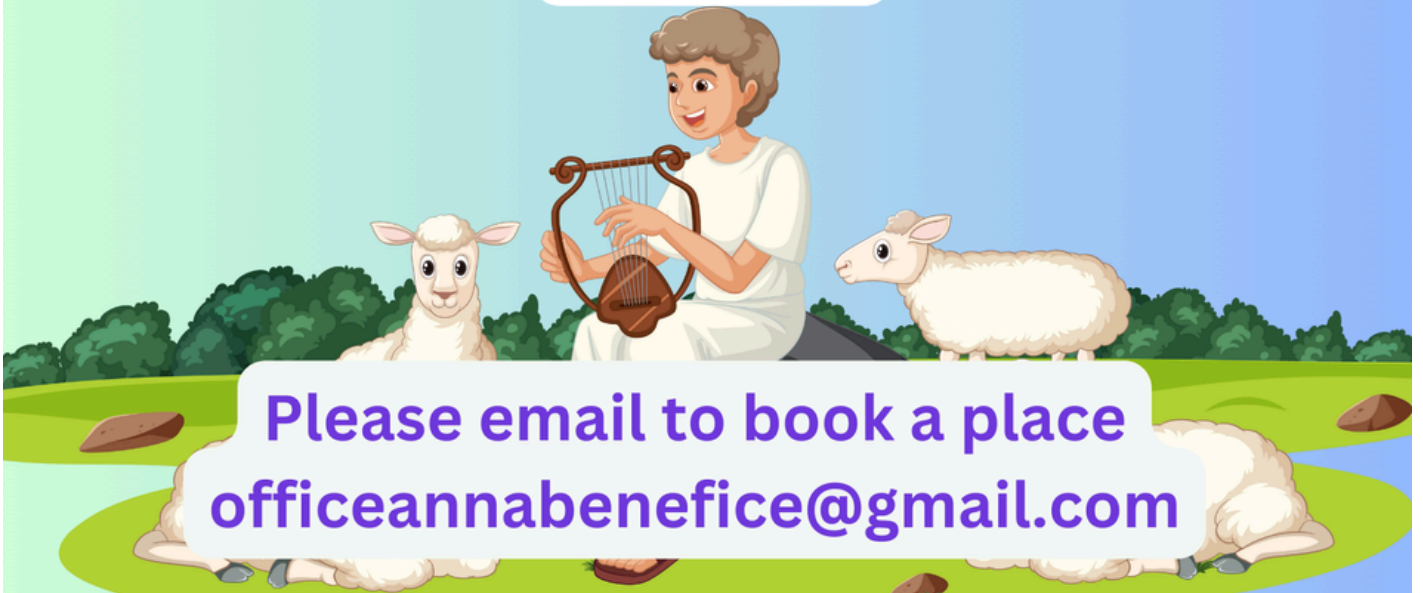
