Distribute these around a site or community

Have a starting point where you give out Christingle bags with an orange, ribbon/tape, candle, sweets, cocktail sticks inside it

Print off the Element sheets

Print off the :What You Need sheet

Display around a site or in windows

Email the sheets or QR codes over a day or week leading up to your online or live service

Use each sheet and activity set as part of activities or groups leading up to your Christingle service



Cook your orange cake in the fire until it is ready (check every 10 minutes but it depends how hot the fire is)

Fill with seed or bird food.
















Take some wool or yarn and wrap this around until it is covered


As you wrap it think about the people who care about you.

Can you fill in the hearts with all the things that you love?




Can you find a rock, stick and acorn or nut to stick on the cards and pass them on to someone.

I wonder what things make it hard to feel God's love?








Can you trace the path with your finger and thank God for the times you have felt His love?

For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son. Whoever puts his trust in God's Son will not be lost but will have life that lasts forever. (NLV)





Psalm 103:5 says God fills our life with good or sweet things.


What are the sweet things in your life? Write or draw them in the jar.






What are the different things in each season that you enjoy?

Or what would you add?




JAMES 1:17













AMAZING, APPEARING PICTURE
